In accordance with The Education Amendment Act (No 3) 201, s11F students who live outside the school zone and apply for enrolment must be accepted in the following order of priority:

- 1. First priority will be given to students accepted for enrolment in a special programme run by the school;
- 2. Second priority will be given to brothers and sisters of current students;
- 3. Third priority will be given to brothers and sisters of former students;
- 4. Fourth priority will be given to children of former students;
- 5. Fifth priority will be given to children of Board employees or children of Board members;
- 6. Sixth priority will be given to all other applicants.

If there are more applicants in the second, third, fourth, fifth or sixth priority groups than there are places available, selection within the priority group will be by a ballot conducted in accordance with instructions issued by the Secretary under Section 11 G (1) of the Education Act 1989. Parents will be informed of the date of any ballot by notice in a community newspaper circulating in the area served by the school.
